Welcome by Nora Lopez and introductions.

Krista Torralva motions to approve minutes from June meeting. Michael Quintanilla seconds. Motion carries with no opposition.

Treasurer report by Laura Garcia:

\$1,541.91 in operations.

\$88,651.73 in gala account.

\$3,470.60 in PayPal account.

\$38,672.13 in SA Foundation (after taking out our record amount of scholarships).

KABB had purchased a table for our gala and said we could have it as a donation (\$3,000).

We got an extension for our 990 and that is in process right now. Any time we give money, like for the scholarship recipients, we need to provide their full name and address to our CPA. Same for professional grants.

Gerardo "Jerry" Hernandez, a longtime supporter, gave us \$4,000.

CPA wants to know if we want to write off \$16,000 for unpaid donation invoices in 2016.

Angelica Hernandez recommends doing it.

Laura Garcia agrees.

Dany Sanchez agrees and recommends looking at those people/businesses and finding out if they're requesting services from us.

Laura motions we write off the 2016 unpaid sponsor balances of \$16K. Angelica seconds. Motion carries without opposition.

Laura will provide a list of folks that did not pay.

Discussion of virtual gala plans, presented by Tony Quesada and Michael Quintanilla. Telemundo is putting the videos together. Silvia Foster-Frau is reaching out to media outlets to collect videos of journalists in the field for a video montage.

Silvia Foster-Frau provides update on SAAHJ's involvement with the News Leaders Association, the organization that surveys newsrooms for their diversity outlooks. Krista Torralva and Tony Quesada will serve on the research groups as representatives of SAAHJ.

Discussion of Fiesta medals. They were ordered, but due to the pandemic they were never distributed. Krista Torralva suggests a curbside pickup event in November, when Fiesta would have been. Further discussion is tabled to the next meeting.

Javier Flores presents results of the SAAHJ election. Javier noted that Francisco Vara-Orta verified the elections results. Both Javier and Francisco abstained from voting to remain independent and impartial. They also noted that they received member questions about whether or not the results of who voted for whom would be made public and the answer is no. Who voted for who is confidential, Javier said.
